Coop Nordic selects NCR for complete front-end solution

ATLANTA –NCR Corporation (NYSE: NCR) today announced that Coop Nordic, the largest food retailer in the Nordic region, is installing NCR RealPOSTM 80c point-of-sale (POS) terminals and NCR RealScanTM bar-code scanners in over 1,000 locations in Denmark.
